Covenant Corner

A reminder of Cobb County Ordinance and Green's Crossing Covenants for ALL home owners.

Cobb County Code

Parking: Vehicles must be parked along the curb, facing in the direction of traffic flow, have a valid tag and be operational. Vehicles may not be parked in designated No Parking areas, where they block access to private driveways or where they restrict the safe flow of traffic. Vehicles may not be parked in the grass or unimproved surface between the roadway and the home's front setback.

Green's Crossing Covenants Home Maintenance

- All Home exteriors are required to be maintained, painted with gutters and trim in good repair. We expect that all homeowners will comply and make any necessary preparations to paint home exteriors if necessary this spring.
- All yards, which are visible from any street must be planted with grass or have other suitable ground cover. All yards must be properly maintained. Proper maintenance requires that at no time should the lawn be more than (6) inches in height in any location. No vegetable gardens in visible yards.
- It is the homeowner's responsibility to keep curbs clean
